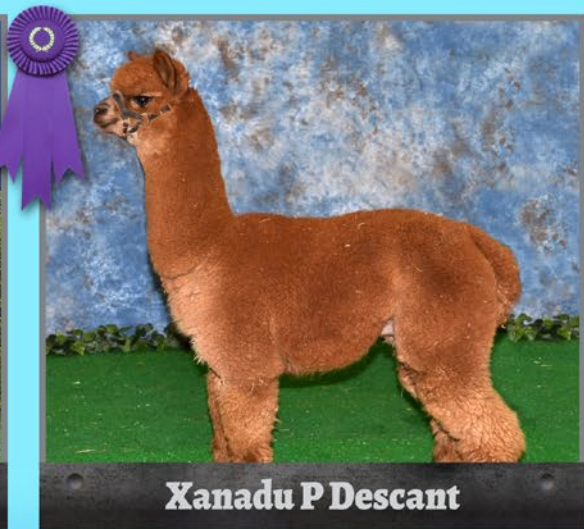

Message from the President

A note from the President

Wow, this year has flown by!! Little did I realize how busy we on the board would be as we worked through the business affairs of TXOLAN Alpaca Association, Inc. It started out kind of like a snowball rolling downhill... the pace went from kind of slow and easy then as the year progressed and we began to deal with all things relating to the show, there was an ever increasing action packed pace until the show is now just thundering down the straight-away. I hope you all realize how lucky you are to have the quality of a board of directors that you have. I have been blessed and proud to work with all of them and folks, they do work at the business of building and presenting the TXOLAN EVENT!!

Across the nation there has been somewhat of a decline in the number and size of alpaca shows due to, among other things, the costs of production, travel, showing, etc. and we did not want the TXOLAN EVENT to become part of any decline, so we set about seeking ways to increase revenue, amp up the showing experience and opportunity and to still make it a fun experience to attend and participate in the activities of the EVENT.

We decided to try some new things, such as add an extra show, the Bluebonnet Stakes. Since our event is so early in the year, the extra show under a separate judge would give folks an early opportunity to begin evaluating their show string with looks from two different judges. Holding two shows on the same weekend provides exhibitors two evaluation opportunities at a reduced cost per show since there is only one trip cost, one hotel cost, one stall cost, etc. In addition to adding an extra halter show, we wanted to give the more Novice breeder/exhibitors an opportunity to show against their peers (in this case other Novices) for Novice ribbons but to also have the opportunity to compete for a color championship in their classes. So, we added in the Novice Classes to the new Bluebonnet Stakes. We are delighted to produce an event offering two full shows for the first time at TXOLAN, but that is not all, in addition, we are offering exhibitors a Walking Fleece Class, Performance Classes and a full Fleece Show!! Is that all.... heck no it is not all... TXOLAN is offering a full day, Friday, of continuing education sessions with experts in a variety of categories. What else do you ask? Welllllll...

Another of the "new things" is, we wanted to develop an online TXOLAN App that you can easily access from your mobile device in addition to having our standard event show book. 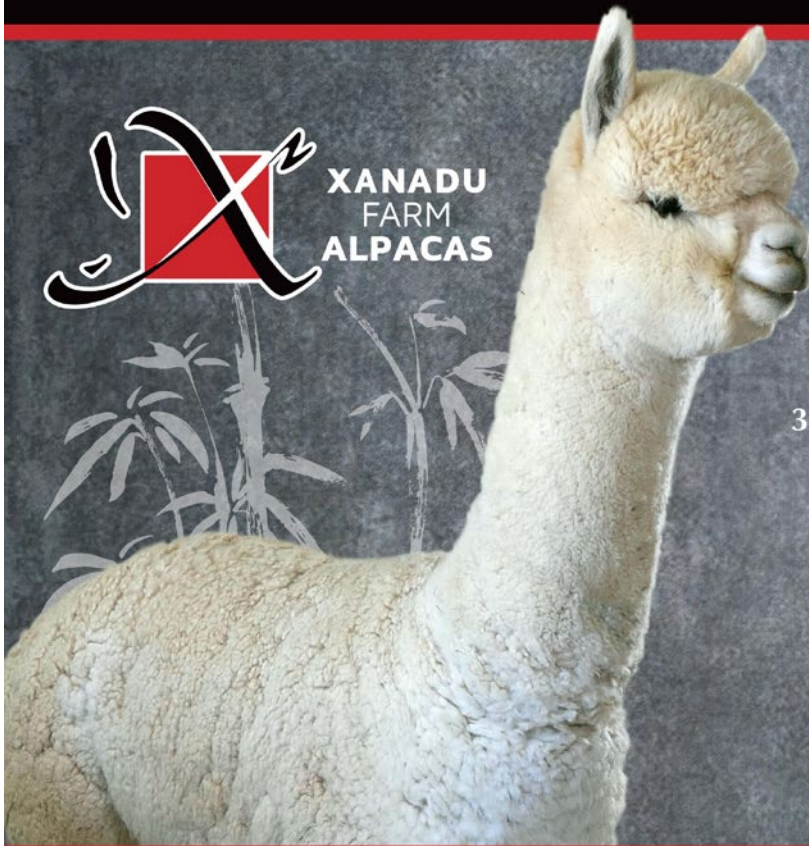

Walking Fleece and Youth Performance

David Barboza volunteering as a ring steward recognized the process and challenges that livestock judging presented and decided to attend the International Alpaca Judging School in 2001. After returning from Peru he began the AOA judges training program and completed his certification in both IAJS and AOA as a halter, fleece, and performance judge. He judged his first show in 2006 and has judged over 45 shows both in the US and Canada. David served a 3 year term on the AOBA board serving as Secretary and President. Promoting youth involvement in alpacas he has

been instrumental in developing alpaca youth judging contests throughout the US. To expand his knowledge of livestock, David is currently enrolled in Graduate Studies at Colorado State University. After serving 29 years in the fire service David continues to serve as a soldier in the California State Military Reserve and Mission Pilot in the Civil Air Patrol. He works in the alpaca industry dividing his time between his ranch, judging, and teaching seminars. In 2006, together with his wife Brenda, they started ACE, Alpaca Continuing Education, which provides cutting edge training and education for the alpaca breeder. Today David and Brenda run their ranch, RanchoNC Alpacas, in the foothills of Northern California and devote their attention to the alpaca industry.

Sara Jane Maclennan has been an AOA Certified Judge since 2005, and is a Judge Trainer for the Judge Apprenticeship Program. She has judged both halter and fleece shows across the United States and Canada. 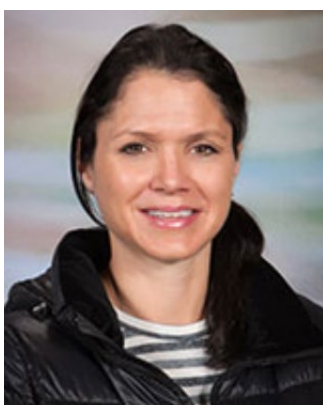

Debbie Miller

Debbie Miller was originally born and raised in Nebraska, the daughter of cattle rancher. In between her time cattle ranching and alpacas she took a job with Valmark Inc., a grocer/clothing store operator on San Juan Island. Starting as a check stand employee she eventually worked her way up to management and then buyer for the company which owned and operated four different store locations. It is her unique combination of experience in livestock and retail which allows her to thrive in the world of alpaca and alpaca retail.

Today she owns and operates Crescent Moon Ranch Alpacas and Alpaca Boutique in the third location Crescent Moon has owned. All three locations with successful store operations each in very different settings.



Lynn Edens

Lynn Edens is the owner of the Little Creek Alpacas and Snowmass Alpacas breeding programs, and co-owner of Imperial Yarn, an all-American yarn and textile production company. She has owned and shown alpacas since 2006. Her involvement in the alpaca industry brings a unique perspective as both an owner and veterinarian. Dr. Maness has spoken at TXOLAN in past years and will be a featured speaker again this year. She is a life time member of the Texas Veterinary Medical Association, as well as a member of the Oklahoma Medical Reserve Corps (MRC), National Animal Health Emergency Response Corp (NAHERC), Oklahoma Veterinary Medical Association (OVMA), and the American Veterinary Medical Association (AVMA).

Dr. Maness will be our on-site veterinarian in case her services are needed. Her services will be available on Thursday afternoon and Friday in case of health certificate (CVI) or microchip issues. Re-issuing a health certificate will be \$25.00. The ARI certificate and BVD by PCR results (lab and date info) will be required. A Bio-Therm Life microchip can be implanted for \$25.00 if needed.

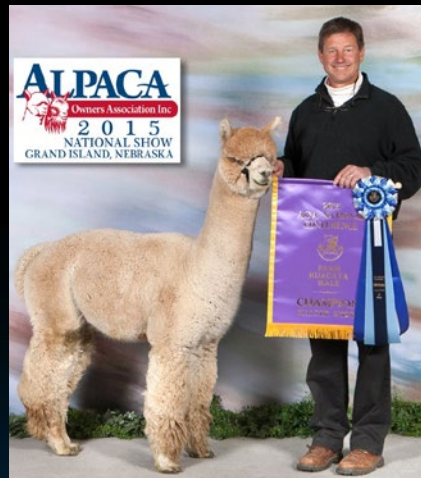
Sally Brandon Placeholder

TXOLAN Sweetheart Spectacular Fleece Show

In Fleece Shows, the fleece or fiber arts item is judged against a standard and given score points and written evaluation comments. This information is very useful to the alpaca owner in determining the best use for the fiber.

Divisions

- Full Fleece - Prime alpaca blanket is judged.
- Spin-off - 2 - 4 oz sample of prime blanket is spun and judged.
- Cottage - Spin-off score is combined with scores for remaining prime blanket.
- Fiber Arts - Items made from alpaca fiber. Can be knitted, crocheted, woven or felted.
- Walking Fleece - Fleece is judged on the alpaca. Conformation is not included in evaluation and scoring.

Halter Show

Youth Performance

- Showmanship, which places emphasis on the handler's show abilities
- Obstacle, which demonstrates the alpaca's ability and willingness to accept training and to work with its handler through a variety of obstacles
- Public Relations, which demonstrates the alpaca's and handler's ability and willingness to perform day to day obstacles that may be encountered when doing public relations events with your alpacas
- Costume Class

Show Rules

- Online Registration must be completed.
- Alpacas must be registered with AOA; NO Pending ARI Registration Papers will be accepted.
- Entries must include copy of AOA Certificate, Buyer's Permission to Show if applicable, completed registration and full registration fees. Buyer's Permission to Show form can be found at www.alpacashows.com.
- Entries must be registered online by 1/31/20.
- Veterinary documents required must be included with entries. For AOA registered animals, there does need to be an identifying tag or number to be able to verify animal presented is the same as noted on the veterinary certificate.
- To be allowed entry to the show, the owner shall submit a copy of the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (Health Certificate), which shall include the AOA number, alpaca name as on the ARI certificate, microchip #, and negative BVD results with testing method for each alpaca entering the show grounds, including companion or private treaty alpacas. The Show Superintendent will keep a copy of the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection as permanent records for the show.
- All alpacas entering the show grounds must show proof of a negative PCR test or a negative VI (VI prior to 1/1/2010) test for BVD (NO other types of BVD testing will be accepted).
- The Halter Show Class Divisions 501 to 510 (Get of Sire; Produce of Dam; Breeders Best Three; Bred & Owned Male; Bred & Owned Female; and Produce of Dam) are Optional Halter classes; entries in these groups REQUIRE that your alpaca ALSO be entered in the appropriate Age-Color-Gender-Breed Halter class. (See Optional Halter Classes, Part VIII, Section 6, AOA Show Division Handbook)
- Exhibitor Rule Halter Show: The owner may enter only 3 alpacas per breed type, per gender, per age division, per color designation.
- Classes may be divided or combined according to AOA show rules, depending on the number of entries.
- Color designation refers to one of the colors shown in the current ARI Color Chart plus the multicolor types described in the Part VII, Section 2, AOA Show Division Handbook. Please use actual color of fiber at skin line, regardless of what your ARI certificate says. All colors will be verified at check-in according to the ARI Color Chart.

Halter Show

What is a Walking Fleece Competition?

Walking Fleece Competition is an opportunity for the exhibitor to enter a fleece competition where the prime fleece is evaluated while still on the alpaca. Conformation is NOT assessed. An AOA Walking Fleece scorecard will be completed for each alpaca in the course of this evaluation/judging process. Placements are made on a highest score basis once all evaluations are completed and tabulated. Oral comments by the Judge may be given during the hands-on evaluation. Judging by an AOA Certified Fleece Judge is required. Walking Fleece Registrations are handled as an Optional Halter Class via the registration System but will follow the rules for a Fleece Show according

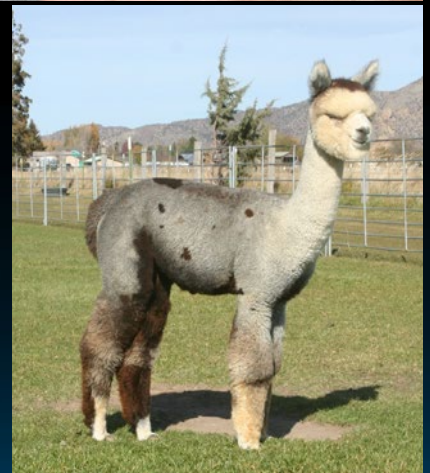

Photo Contest

Definition of Categories

- Alpacas and Friends: Photos of alpacas interacting with their friends. Friends may be other alpacas, other 4-legged creatures, or even 2- legged creatures!
- Black and White: Black and white photos of alpacas saved in the grayscale color space.
- Crias: Photos of those loveable, huggable alpaca babies.
- Alpaca Close-ups: Portraits of Alpacas.
- Farm Scene: Scenic photos of alpacas and where they live.
- Humor: Photos of alpacas doing what makes us laugh.

Judging Criteria

- Focus: Distinctness or clarity of an image rendered by the camera.
- Depth of Field: Range of acceptably sharp focus in front of and behind the distance the lens is focused on.
- Exposure: Light striking a sensitized material (film or paper emulsion).
- Lighting: Distribution of light on an object or figure in the photo.
- Composition: Placement or arrangement of visual elements in photo, as distinct from the subject in the photo.
- Rule of Thirds: Guideline which proposes that an image should be imagined as divided into nine equal parts by two equally-spaced horizontal lines and two equally-spaced vertical lines, and important compositional elements should be placed along these lines or their intersections; thus creating more tension, energy and interest in the composition than simply centering the subject would.

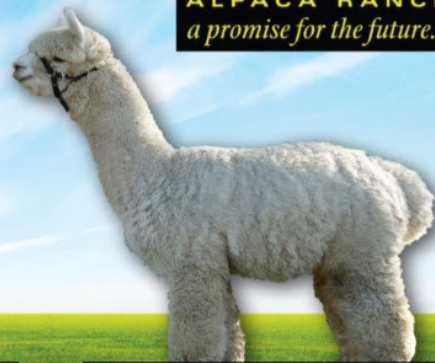
